Schools require all staff to have Police Clearance, and Teachers must have SACE registration. If you don't have these yet, please obtain them before you apply. You cannot be legally employed without them. If you do have them, the SACE registration number and the date of your latest Police Clearance must appear on the CV. If they do not – we assume you do not have them.

To send your CV, please use the email address at the bottom of the specific advert you are applying for. Remember to say what you are applying for!

Your CV should be a fully editable Word or PDF file. No scans. No CVs in CAPs. Make sure your CV has been proofread for mistakes before you send it! If you are employed, state why you are leaving and the notice you need to give! Should you disregard these instructions we are not obliged to respond to your CV

Every CV requires at least two referees who *must* be recent past or current employers, their name, designation, capacity in which they supervised your work, and day-time land-line phone number at work - no cellphones!
